STORAGE YARD POLICIES

North Harbor Diesel's policies for usage are for the benefit of everyone. Employee and customer health & safety are the Company's major interests.

The following items should be adhered to, to keep the Company clean and safe:

- All persons entering NHD yards do so at their own risk
- NHD is not responsible - at any time - for accidents, injuries or death to persons working in Company facilities
- **The following activities are prohibited at all times in North Harbor Diesel Storage Yards:**
 - ✓ Pressure washing of any kind
 - ✓ Painting & coating (brush or spray)
 - ✓ Engine / propulsion system operation, repair or replacement
 - ✓ Hull repair of any kind
 - ✓ Bilge cleaning
 - ✓ Refueling, fuel & lubrication system repair or replacement
 - ✓ Welding & grinding of any kind
 - ✓ Buffing & waxing
 - ✓ Marine sanitation device (MSD) repair & replacement
 - ✓ Zinc anode repair & replacement
 - ✓ Vessel deconstruction
 - ✓ Exterior cleaning activities of any kind
- Do not distract Company employees while they are on customer vessels
- Stay well clear of all heavy transportation & moving equipment. Remember: operators & spotters cannot see all areas while in motion
- Do not adjust or tamper with boat stands in any way. Yard crews are available to do this for you

- Vehicles must park only in their own Vessel storage space. The speed limit in all yards is 5 MPH. Violators will be banned from yards
- Ladders, stairs or catwalks (not provided) used for boat entry and exit are used at an individual's own risk
- On-board stays are allowed; please alert Management if longer than 2 days. No liquids or materials may be drained from the vessel (any of the afore-mentioned prohibitions in Storage Yards)
- Raising of sails or removal of standing rigging is prohibited while in Storage yards. No one is permitted to go aloft while in yards
- Vessel storage spaces must be cleaned daily. No storage is allowed under a vessel
- Entire space is to be cleaned upon completion of stay in yards. Dumpsters are for normal trash and garbage
- Perishables, scrap materials and large project waste are to be removed from Yards by vessel owners
- Please remember to keep your boat and our Yards clean and safe!
- No NHD power or hand tools are rented or loaned out. Employees are not permitted to do so
- Please do not help yourself to other materials or stores. If a customer needs help, ask for assistance through NHD Management
- All facility shop areas are off-limits to customers – unless escorted by a NHD employee
- Never disconnect or unplug another vessel's shore power or other electrical devices. If additional electrical outlets are needed, contact NHD Management
- No public displays of intoxication will be tolerated
- All pets must be on a leash and cleaned up after by the pet owner
- While the vessel is in any yard or on docks, a set of keys must be left with Management
